STATEMENT OF INTENT:

Cordova Electric Cooperative wishes to honor two 2020 graduating high school seniors, home school students, or students having passed their GED in the 2019/2020 school year.

- One (1) \$2,000.00 (two thousand dollar) scholarship will be awarded to a student seeking to further their education in *any area of the electrical industry*, which includes, but is not limited to the following: power production, journeyman lineman, apprentice lineman, accounting including accounts payable/accounts receivable/payroll, customer service representative, executive director, executive assistant, finance manager, human resources, communications, IT, etc.
- One (1) \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollar) scholarship will be awarded to a student entering *any vocational/technical or trade program* (electrical industry not a required field). Examples include: health related fields like nursing and dentistry, emergency services and first responders, veterinary techs, auto/marine repair, diesel mechanic, geological and petroleum technician, culinary arts, welding, plumbing, electricians, carpentry, construction, web design/network administration, paralegal, court reporter, private and commercial flight, and any training/certification offered at AVTEC.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. Must be a graduating CHS high school senior, homeschool student, or have passed the GED in the 2019-20 school year.
2. Graduate's parents/legal guardians, or self must be a current member of Cordova Electric Cooperative.
3. Must be entering the field of electrical utility operation to be considered for the \$2,000.00 scholarship.
4. Must submit a copy of high school transcript.
5. Must write an essay that includes the following (Minimum of 250 words):
 - a. Describe your plans for future education.
 - b. Tell us your reasons for pursuing a career in the electric utility industry or trade school.
 - c. Explain the differences in being a member of a cooperative electric utility versus receiving power from a private business.
 - d. Tell us why a positive work environment is essential.

Submit completed scholarship application (this page plus transcript and essay) by **March 13, 2020** by mail to Cordova Electric Cooperative, Attention: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 20, Cordova, AK 99574, or deliver it to the CEC office at 705 Second Street.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The Cordova Electric Cooperative Scholarship Committee will review all applications and will ensure there is no conflict of interest in regard to personal relationships with any and all applicants.

1. The recipient will be announced at the CEC Annual Meeting in March and at the annual CHS Scholarship Awards Night.

FUND DISBURSEMENT:

1. Funds will be sent directly to the school and/or training program of recipient's choice.
2. It is the responsibility of the recipient to notify Cordova Electric Cooperative of the school and/or training program name and address.
